Harvard Museum Gets Minerals.

CAMBRIDGE, Mass., March 21.—About 1,000 mineral specimens from one of the finest private collections in Europe have been bought by the Mineralogical Museum of Harvard University. They comprise a major part of the collection of Dr. Hans V. Karabacek of Vienna. The new material is the most notable since the bequest of Albert Holden's important collection to the museum in 1913, according to Professor Charles Palache, curator.
